Make sure your beneficiary designation is up to date. Your beneficiary is the person, people or entities that are eligible to receive any benefit payments upon your death.

To designate or change your beneficiary, simply complete the <u>Beneficiary Designation</u> Form and return it to IPERS, or log into <u>My Account</u>. Copies of the form are available at our Iowa State Fair booth as well.

One-on-one retirement counseling options

IPERS offers different kinds of one-on-one retirement counseling so you can choose the option that best suits you:

- In-Person Counseling by Appointment We offer in-person counseling at our offices in Des Moines. Appointment times are available weekdays, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.
- In-Person Counseling Walk-In • We offer in-person, walk-in counseling at our offices in Des Moines weekdays, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. (IPERS prefers that you make an appointment for in-person counseling so you can receive services as quickly as possible.)
- Phone Counseling We offer counseling by phone weekdays, 1 – 5:30 p.m.

We accept appointments for each kind of counseling. Call 800-622-3849 or log in to My Account to make an appointment. IPERS will continue to offer group education counseling via Zoom only.

FY2022 Contribution Rates

FY2022 Contribution Rates, listed below, took effect on July 1, 2021. Regular member and employer contributions remained unchanged from FY2021. Contribution rates for Protection Occupation and Sheriff/Deputy Sheriff members and employers were reduced by 0.50%.

As an IPERS member, both you and your employers contribute money to the IPERS Trust Fund every month. These contributions are pooled and invested to pay for future retirement benefits. At retirement, your benefit is calculated based on your age, salary and years of service. The longer you work in public service, the larger your benefit.
